

Dr. George Grossberg is the Samuel W. Fordyce Professor in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Neuroscience and director of the Division of Geriatric Psychiatry at Saint Louis University School of Medicine. A Diplomat of the National Board of Medical Examiners and a Distinguished Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association, Dr. Grossberg is a member of several professional societies. He started the first geriatric psychiatry program in Missouri as well as the first Alzheimer's Disease Community Brain Bank. He is a former president of the American Association for Geriatric Psychiatry and the International Psychogeriatric Association. Among his many awards, Dr. Grossberg received the Fleishman-Hilliard Award for career contributions to geriatrics and the Missouri Adult Day Care Association Outstanding Physician Award for supporting programs that allow seniors to live independently or at home with their families.
