
## **GET STARTED**

## **ACCESS THE EVENT**

- You must be <u>registered</u> to attend OSS+ELC NA 2020.
- You will need your confirmation number and email address (found in your registration confirmation email) to enter the event.
- The event will be open to attendees starting on Monday, June 29 at 8:30 am CDT, one hour before keynotes start.
- All event participants must abide by our Code of Conduct.
- Make sure to join our <u>OSS+ELC Slack Workspace</u> to network with other registered attendees! Email <u>events@linuxfoundation.org</u> if you didn't receive your invitation.
- If you're viewing the event on a screen smaller than 15 inches, we recommend that you zoom out manually on your browser by pressing "Control" + "-" if you're on a PC, or "Command ( $\Re$ )" + "-" if you're on a Mac.

## **UPDATE YOUR PROFILE & SET YOUR TIME ZONE**

- The event is held on Central Daylight Time (CDT)/UTC-5 and all times listed in the platform and on Sched will default to this time zone. However, you can adjust to your local time zone in both Sched and in the Virtual Event Platform easily!
- In the event platform, go to the "Profile" tab to update your time zone.
- You will also need to go to <u>ossna2020.sched.com</u> or the "Schedule & Agenda Builder" tab in the platform to change your time zone for Sched.
- Throughout the event, you can download resources to your briefcase to access at a later time.



## **GET HELP**



## **RUN A SYSTEM CHECK**


- Run a <u>system check</u> to ensure your computer is configured properly for the virtual event platform.


## **NETWORK & COLLABORATE**
