FIRST TIME REGISTRANTS

Once you choose which enrollment path applies to you (member or non-member), click on the applicable red button. From there it will take you to a secondary page where you will fill in your registration information.

- Enter an email address that you would like to enroll with. (For non-members, please enroll with the same email address that is linked to your PayPal account.) Links needed to attend the program(s) will be included in confirmation and reminder emails that will be sent to email addresses that are used to enroll. You must save the emails that you receive, as there is no other way to access the event without the links that are listed in the emails.
- 2. Create a password that is at least six alphanumeric characters long, with both letters and numbers. Passwords are case sensitive and are required to login to each program.
- 3. Fill out all of the other required information to complete enrollment. All fields marked with an asterisk (*) are required fields. When all fields are completed, click 'SUBMIT'.

The first time you enroll, your information will be saved in the platform in the form of a profile. Profiles can be edited once an attendee is logged in for a live program by clicking the 'Profile' button in the upper right corner of the page.

When you have successfully enrolled, you will be redirected to a confirmation page and will receive a confirmation email with a link to log into the event on the live day and a link to add the event to your calendar.

MAKING PAYMENT (FOR NON-MEMBERS ONLY WHERE APPLICABLE)

For webcast enrollment, a payment is required for all non-members.

After you have completed enrollment you will be redirected to a page to enter your payment information. Acceptable forms of payment include pre-paid credit card/gift card or a credit card (Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover).

RETURNING USERS/USERS THAT PREVIOUSLY ENROLLED AND LOGIN
