

# ATTENDEE GUIDE

## **GET STARTED**

- All event participants must abide by our <u>Code of Conduct</u>.
- The event will be open to attendees starting on Friday, September 25 at 12:00pm EDT, 3 days before the event starts. Take advantage of this early access to become familiar with the platform, update your profile, and set your time zone.
- The event is held on **Eastern Daylight Time (EDT) / UTC -4** and all times listed in the platform and on <u>Sched</u> will default to EDT. However, you can change the default on Sched to your local time zone easily.
- Make sure to join our <u>ONES Slack Workspace</u> to network with other registered attendees! Email <u>events@linuxfoundation.org</u> if you didn't receive your invitation within 2 hours of registering during EDT business hours.

## **ACCESS THE EVENT**

- You must be registered to attend ONES 2020.
- You will need your confirmation number (found in your registration confirmation email) and the same email address you used to register for the event.
- If you're viewing the event on a screen smaller than 15 inches, we recommend that you zoom out manually.
- Run a <u>system check</u> to ensure your computer is configured properly for the virtual event platform.
- Run a compatibility check, which tests your audio devices.
- If you encounter any issues, please refer to INXPO's additional computer tips.

## **UPDATE YOUR PROFILE**

Within the event platform, click on the "Profile" tab to access the followina:

- Update your personal information & add a photo.
- Change your time zone (all times listed default to EDT UTC -4).
- Access your Briefcase. This is where you can view your downloaded resources such as videos, white papers, and more from the Technical Showcase.
- View My Achievements (your Badge collection).
- You will also need to go to <u>ones2020.sched.com</u>
  or the "Schedule & Agenda Builder" tab in the platform
  to change your time zone for Sched.

## **TECH SUPPORT**

For technical support inside the platform, choose "Tech Support" under the "Info" tab in the top navigation bar, where a support representative will be standing by to help. You can start a chat and view helpful resources and documentation.
